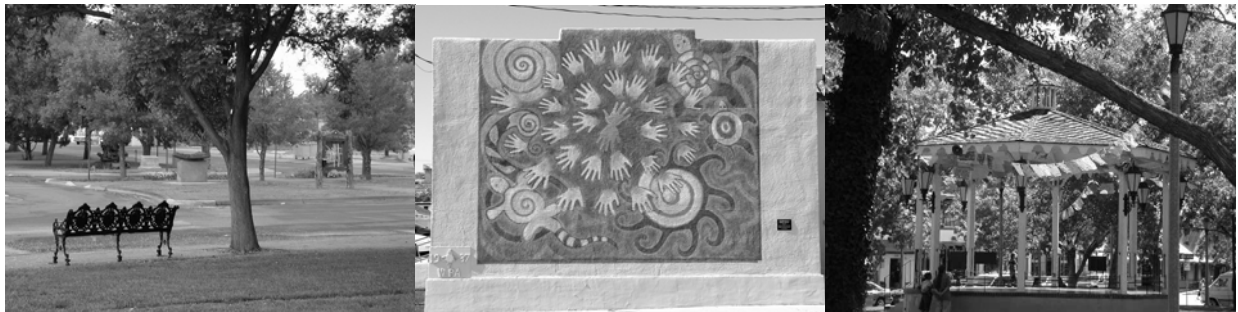


2008 ICIP Workshops

The Local Government Division/DFA is sponsoring workshops to guide communities in developing the 2010-2014 Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan. Workshops will detail how to plan, use the website, link ICIP and capital outlay, budget, and estimate costs.
